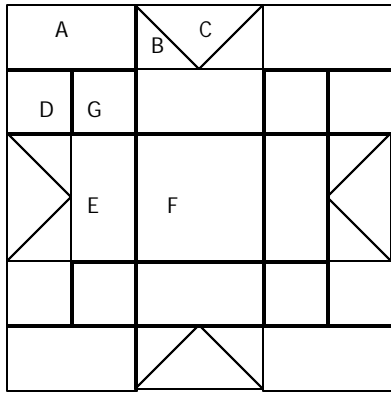


9" Maple Star



Cutting

Background: A + C: Cut eight rectangles 2" X 3½"

D: Cut four squares 2" X 2"

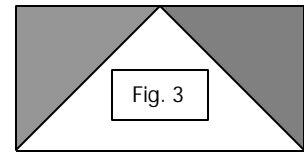
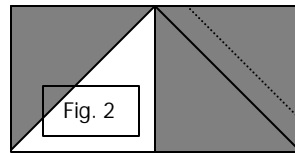
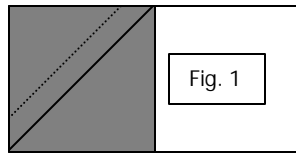
Dark red: B and G: Cut twelve squares 2" X 2"

F: Cut one square 3½ X 3½"

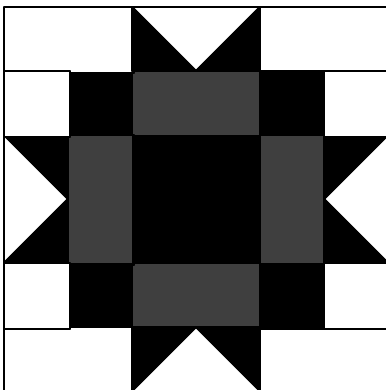
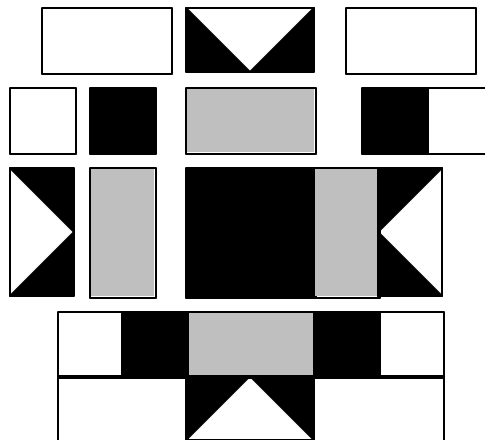
Medium red: E Cut 4 rectangles 2" X 3½"

February's colors are red and white. The dark is a dark red and the medium is a medium red. All background is white or white on white. Please check your reds for bleeding!!

Draw a line diagonal line on the back of **eight** dark red squares. Place one on each of **four** white rectangles. Sew on the line. (fig. 1) Press to the **red** and then trim on the dashed line. Place a second **dark red** square on the rectangle and repeat the process. (fig. 2) You will end up with **four** flying geese units. (fig. 3) They should measure **2" X 3½"**.



Position all the patches along with the flying geese units according to the star at right. Sew patches into rows. Sew rows into block.
