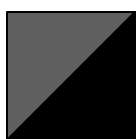
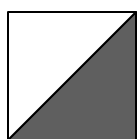


Cutting

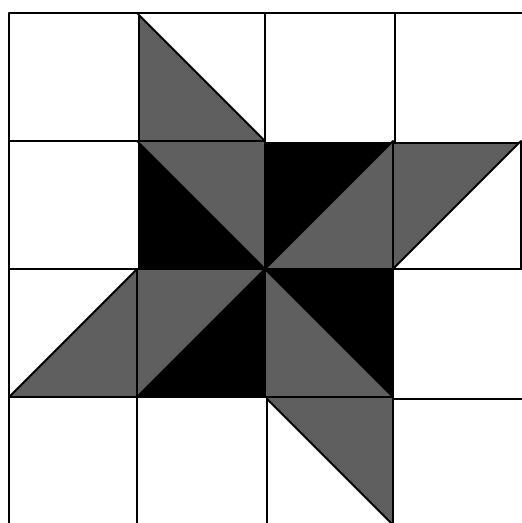
- A** Cut eight squares cream $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
- B** Cut four squares red $2\frac{7}{8}$ "
- C** Cut two squares cream $2\frac{7}{8}$ "
- D** Cut two squares dark blue $2\frac{7}{8}$ "



Draw a diagonal line on the back of the two **C** squares and the two **D** squares. Lay each on top of a red **B** square. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal line. Cut on diagonal line and press to the dark fabric.



You will have four units like each of these. Arrange them carefully as shown below and sew together adding the cream squares.
