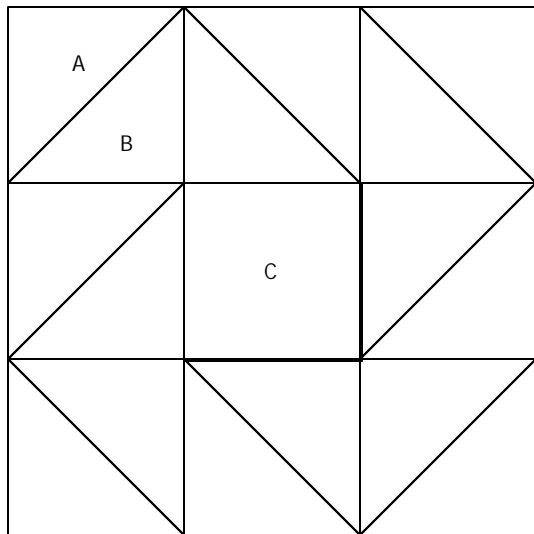


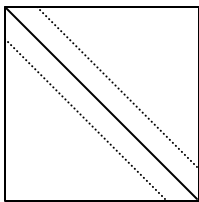
9" Friendship Star



Cutting

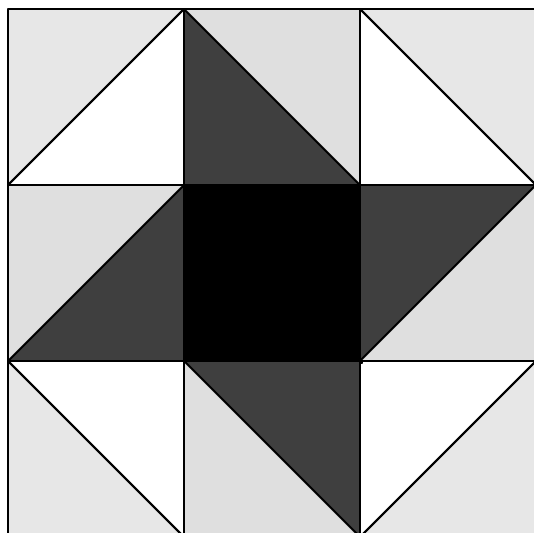
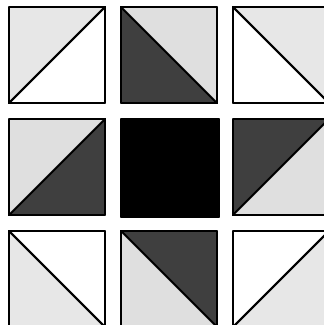
Light: Cut two squares $3 \frac{7}{8}'' \times 3 \frac{7}{8}''$
2nd light: Cut two squares same as above
Medium: Cut two squares $3 \frac{7}{8}'' \times 3 \frac{7}{8}''$
2nd medium: Cut two squares same as above
Dark: C: Cut one square $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}''$

Your choice for colors!! You will need **two lights** and **two mediums** and **one dark**. Color gets all the credit but **contrast** does all the work!! Have fun!



Draw a diagonal line on the back of the all four **light** squares. Make **two** pairs with each of the **mediums**. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}''$ on each side of the diagonal line. Cut on diagonal line and press to the darker fabric.

Arrange the units carefully as shown at the right. Sew them together into rows and the rows into blocks.
