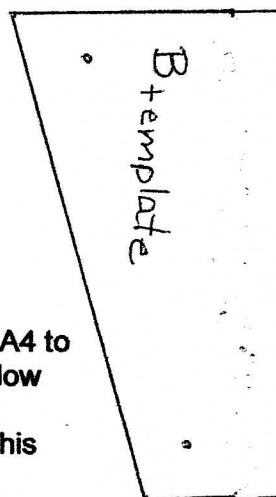


## Block of the Month June 2009

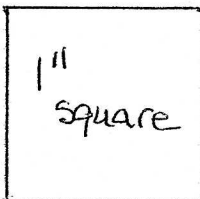
For June we will make a House Block. Background B will be a blue sky. Use scraps to make door D, chimney C, windows W, roof R, and house A. Block will finish 10" x 8" (10½" x 8½" unfinished).

Cut: house A1: 9" x 1" A2: 9" x 1½" A3: 5" x 1" - 2 pieces A4: 1¾" square - 8 pieces chimney C: 1" x 1¼" door D: 1½" x 2¼" roof R: 1 Rtemplate- cut on fold.	sky B1: 10½" x 1¾" B2: 5¼" x 1¼" - 2 pieces B3: 1¼" x 5" - 2 pieces B template: cut 1 & 1 Breverse window W1: 1¾" square - 4 pieces W2: 1½" x 1¾"

Sew A4's to each side of W1's. Sew W2 to an A4W1A4 patch. Sew another A4W1A4 to the other side of W2. To remaining A4W1A4 patches, sew an A3 to each bottom. Now sew A4W1A4A3 patch to each side of D.  
 Sew A2 to top of door patch. Sew windows patch on top of A2. Sew A1 on top of this patch.  
 Sew Btemplate & Breverse to each side of R template, matching dots. Sew B2 patches to both sides of C, then sew to top of roof R. Sew B1 on top of chimney.
