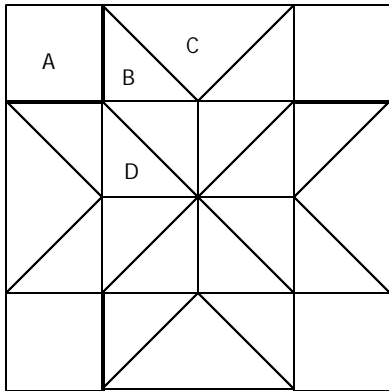


8" Sarah's Choice



Cutting

Background: A - Cut four squares $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$.

C - Cut four rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$

Floral-dark: B - Cut four squares $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

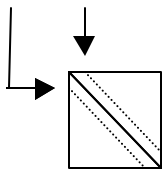
D - Cut two squares $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$

Green-medium: B - Cut four squares $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

D - Cut two squares $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$

March is a good month to think of the flowers that will surely come soon. Let's use a dark floral and a nice green...and white for the background again.

Sew here



Draw a diagonal line on the two **green $2\frac{7}{8}''$ squares**. Place each on a **floral $2\frac{7}{8}''$ square**. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}''$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on solid line and press to the floral.

Makes four units like this.



Arrange as shown in the block and sew together.

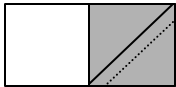

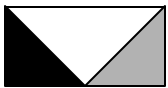
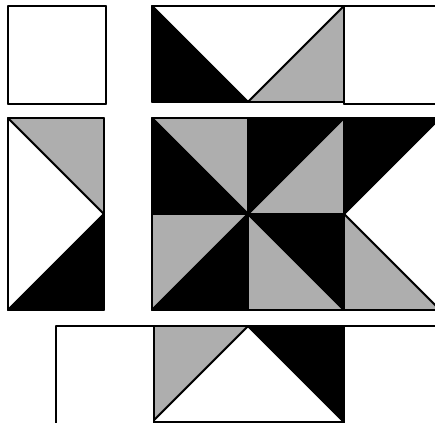
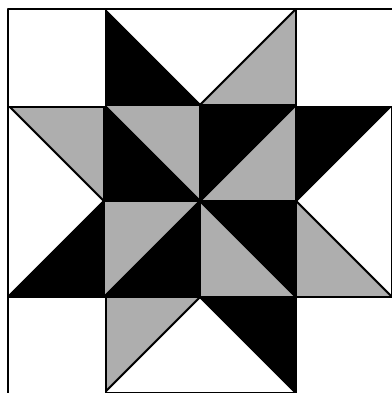

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the **four floral and four green $2\frac{1}{2}''$ squares**. Place a **green** on each of **four** white rectangles--see figure 1 for placement. Sew on the **drawn** line. Press to the **green** and then trim on the dashed line. Place the **floral** square on the rectangle and repeat the process. (fig. 2) You will end up with **four** flying geese units. (fig. 3) They should measure **$2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$** .

Arrange patches and geese units with pinwheel and sew into rows. Then sew rows together.
