

Block of the Month-November 2007

For November we will do a Lighthouse. Choose a blue sky for your background, a yellow for the shining light and your choice for the lighthouse colors. Below are two ways to construct the block- by making templates, or paper piecing. Lighthouse will finish 6" x 8" (6 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished).

Template block: Trace and cut out templates, including dots. (Hint-use freezer paper). Cut out with two pieces of fabric wrong sides together to get both piece & reverse piece.

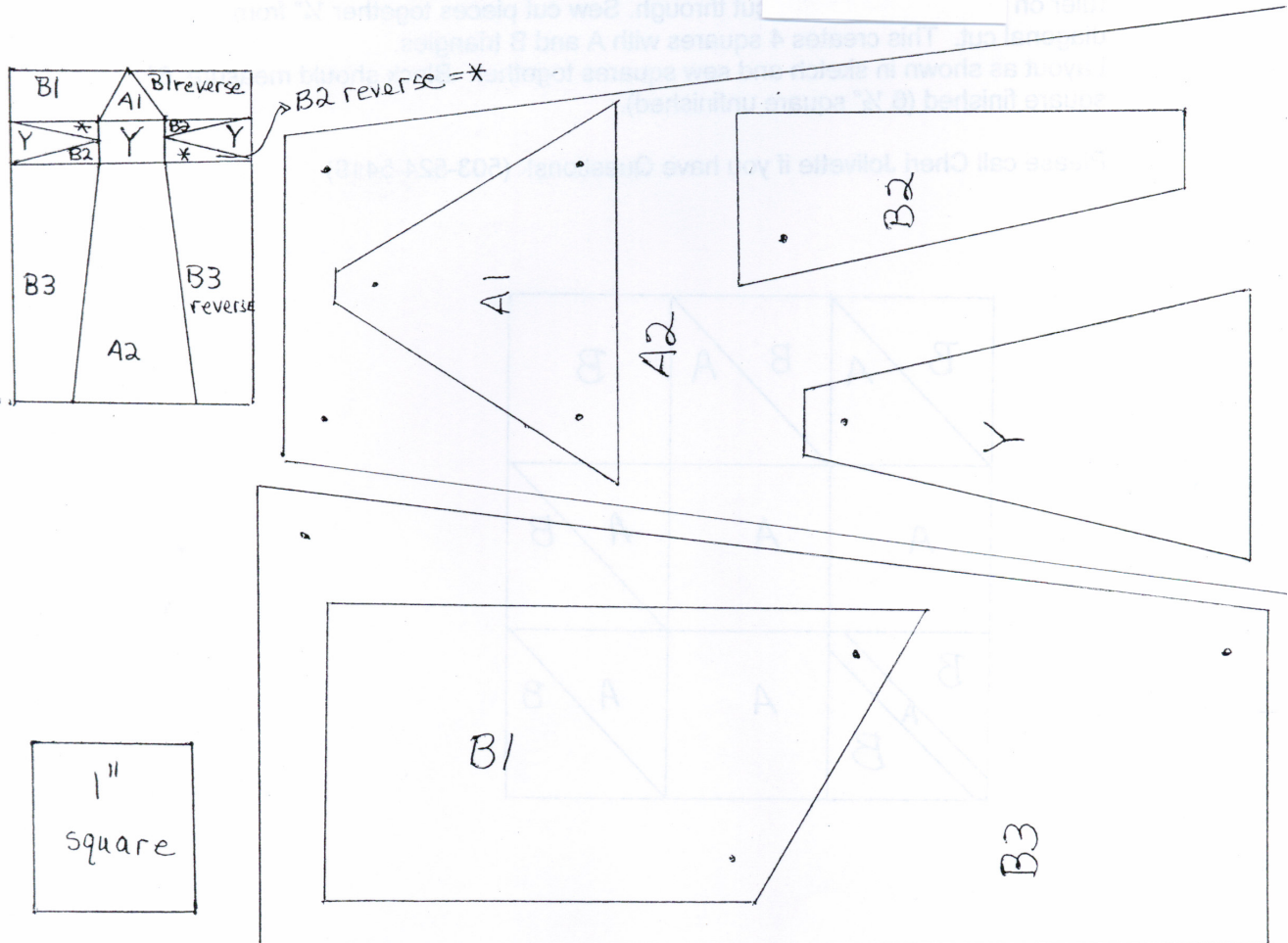
CUT: lighthouse A- cut 1 A1, cut 1 A2

Yellow- cut 1 2" x 1 1/2" piece & 2 Y pieces

Background B- cut 1 each B1 & B1reversed
cut 2 each B2 & B2reversed
cut 1 each B3 & B3reversed

Sew A1 to B1 matching dots, then sew A1 to B1reversed. Sew A2 to B3, then sew A2 to B3reversed. Sew B2 to Y, matching dot. Then sew B2reversed to Y, again matching dot. Repeat for other pieces. Now sew Y 2"x1 1/2" piece between B2-Y patches. Sew A1-B1 patch on top and A2-B3 patch below.

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For paper piecing, please leave paper on block. Sew each section by starting with lowest circled number and going up in order. After sewing 10-11-12 patch, attach a yellow 2"x1 1/2" piece. Attach 7-8-9 patch to other side of yellow. Sew 4-5-6 patch on top and 1-2-3 patch below. For questions, call Cheri Jolivette at
