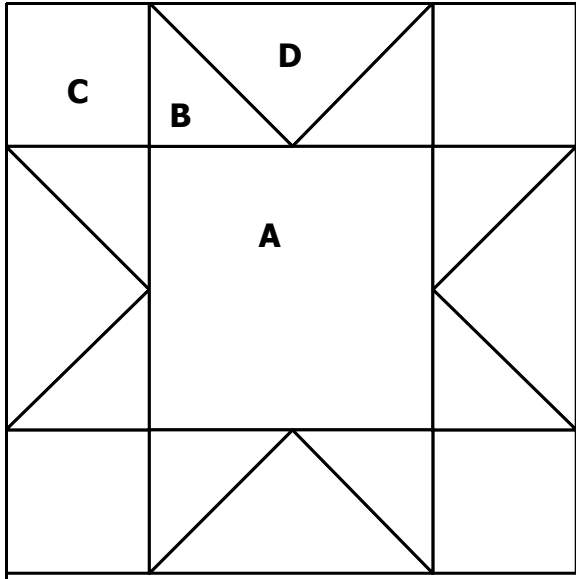


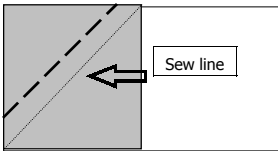
8" Sawtooth Star



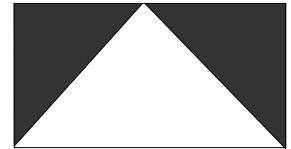
Cutting

- A** Cut one square medium $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$
- B** Cut eight dark squares $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$
- C** Cut four light squares $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$
- D** Cut four light rectangles $4\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$

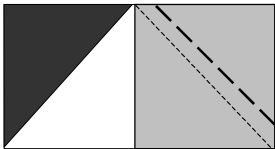
Think autumn colors when making this block. The **B** patches will be your darkest fabric. The **A** patch will be a medium and the **C's** and **D's** will be your lightest/background fabric. Enjoy...Make one for the drawing and one for yourself!!



Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of **B** patch and place on **D** patch. Sew on drawn line. Press toward seam allowance and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from sewing line (heavy dashed line).



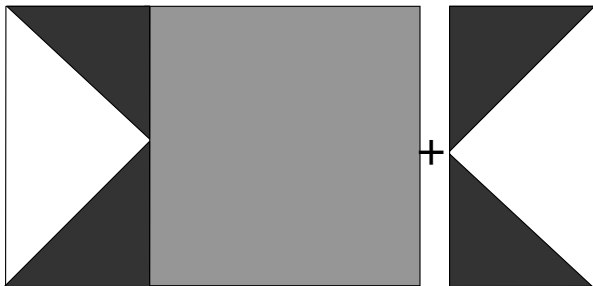
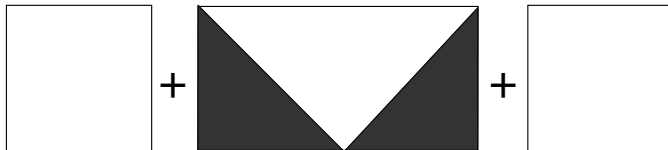
Make **four** units with light **D** patches and dark **B** patches.



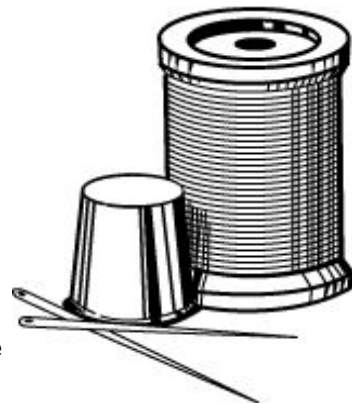
Repeat as above with second **B** patch.

Sew a light **C** patch to each end of **two** of the above units. Sew the remaining two units to opposite sides of the **A** patch.

Sew together as below.
