Bring completed block(s) to the guild meeting.

Fabric choices:

Center - Print that coordinates with green fabric

Blossom Sections - Green

Background - White or light gray

Corner:


A - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 1

Blossom:

B - 2" x 3 1/2" Cut 4 C - 2" x 3 1/2" Cut 4

Background:

D - 2" x 2" Cut 8 E - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 4



Assemble:

Use Flip and Turn method (or your favorite method) to make flying geese. Place one D block on C rectangle. Stitch, trim seam, and flip open. Place other D block at other end of C rectangle, stitch, trim seam and flip open. Repeat for other flying geese.

Sew remaining pieces together following block diagram. Finish assembling following block diagram.

Finished size: 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" to make 9" x 9" quilt block.
