Fabric choices: House - your choice of bright color
Roof and Door - Brown, gray or black
Background - White

House:

A - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Cut 2
B - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Cut 1

Roof and Door:

C - 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 1
D - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Cut 1

Background:

E - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 2

Assemble:

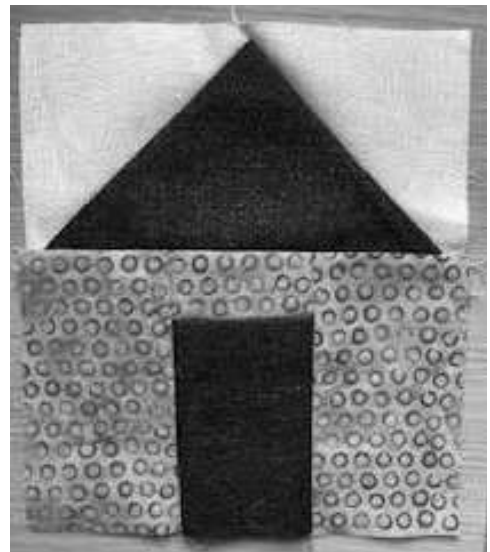
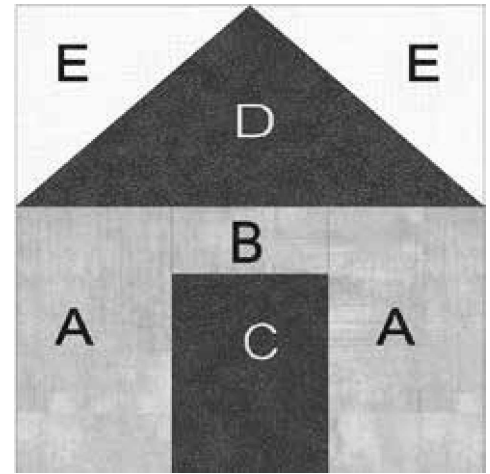
Make flying geese block using flip and turn method. Place one E block on D rectangle. Stitch, trim seam, and flip open. Press open prior to repeating with second E block on other end of D rectangle.

Sew remaining pieces together following block diagram.

Finished size: 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" to make 6 x 7" quilt block.

Quilters abbreviations:
RST = Right Sides Together
HST = Half Square Triangle
