

BLOCK OF THE MONTH - June, Beautiful Butterfly

Fly into spring with a beautiful butterfly.

Fabric choices: Background - white or off white
 Butterfly wings - choose a dark and light
 Butterfly body - any color

Wing fabric:

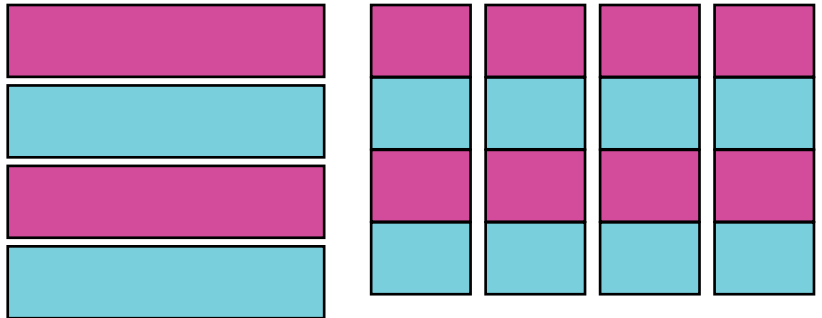
A - 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" cut 2
 B - 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" cut 2

Butterfly body:

C - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" cut 1

Background:

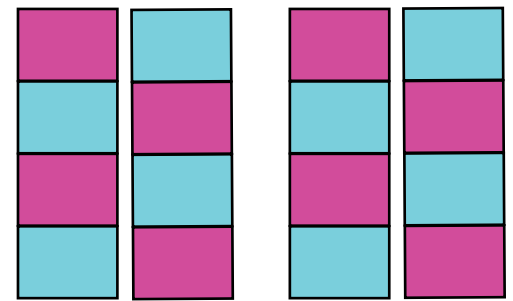
D - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" cut 4
 E - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut 2



Make the wings

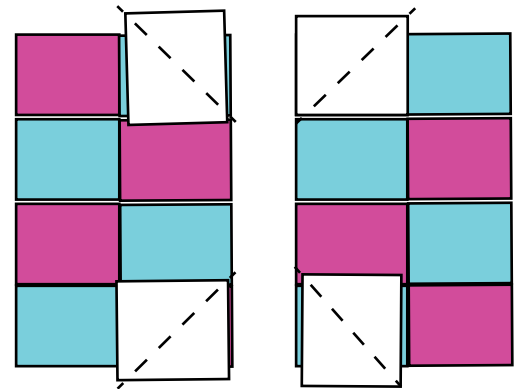
Sew together along long edges A & B strips as shown.
 Press to darkest side. Next cut the new A/B block into four 3 1/2" sections.
 Join the new strips together alternating the blocks as shown.

Using the flip and turn method sew background square D to top and bottom of each wing as shown.



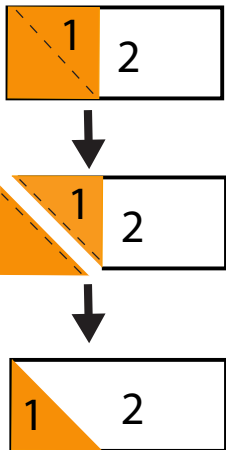
Butterfly body

Sew background D squares to either end of body rectangle C.
 Press to body
 Sew butterfly wings to either side of body, completing the butterfly!

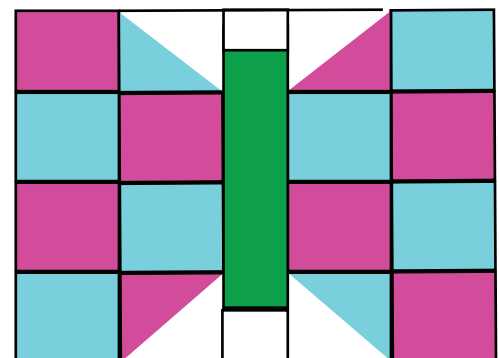


Finished Size: 12" x 14"

 RST = Right Sides Together
 HST = Half Square Triangle
