BLOCK OF THE MONTH - February, Churn Dash

I have decided to switch from the theme of houses, trees, etc. for the Block of the Month. Instead, we will explore some blocks in a 3 by 3 grid.

They will be fairly simple so they are quick to put together. I hope that means more blocks put together, and maybe more Comforting Quilts.

Fabric choices:
Contrast - Blue, green, or teal
Center - Coordinating larger print
Light - White or cream

Contrast: A - 4" x 4" Cut 2 (will yield four triangles)
B - 2" x 15" Cut 1 (will use for strip set to be cut into squares)

Center C - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 1

Background: D - 4" x 4" Cut 2 (will yield four triangles)
E - 2" x 15" Cut 1 (will use for strip set to be cut into squares)

Assemble:

Make half-square triangles: Place one A and one D squares right side together. Draw diagonal line. Sew scant 1/4" seam on both sides of diagonal. See diagram.

Cut along diagonal line. Open and press, then trim to 3 1/2" square. Repeat with remaining A and D squares.

Make strip set by sewing B and E strips long sides together. Press and cut into four squares, each 3 1/2". Your strip set should be slightly longer than needed to allow for squaring of edges.

Finish assembling following block diagram.

Finished size: 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" to make 9" x 9" quilt block.

Quilters abbreviations:
RST = Right Sides Together
HST = Half Square Triangle
