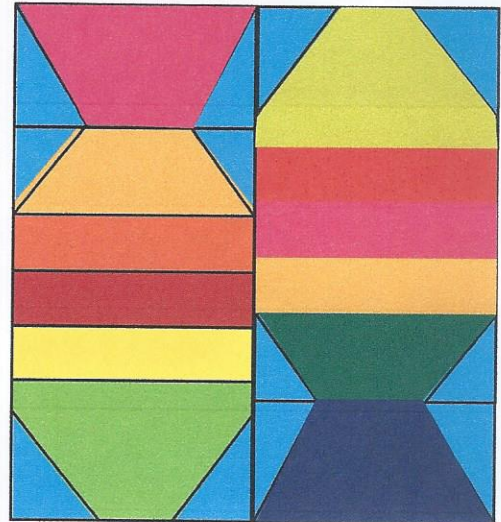


## BLOCK OF THE MONTH - September, One Fish, Two Fish

Fabric: Light blue background  
 Fish made with at least 3 prints

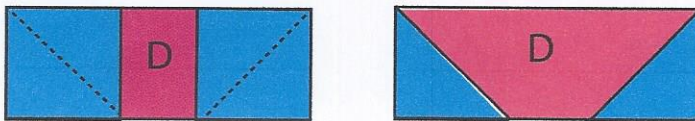
Background: 3" x 3" square cut 12  
 Fish: A 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" cut 2  
       B 2" x 6 1/2" cut 6  
       C 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" cut 2  
       D 3" x 6 1/2" cut 2



Make fish: Sew together three of the B blocks along 6 1/2" sides, using one of each color.

Sew A block to one side and on opposite side sew C block.

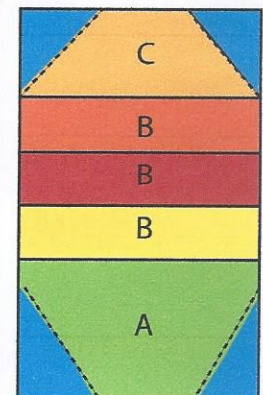
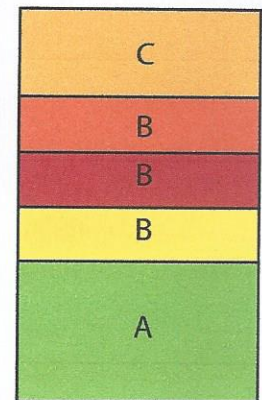
Next draw a line diagonally on all the background squares. With RST place a background square on each corner of the fish block. Sew on the line. Press and trim.



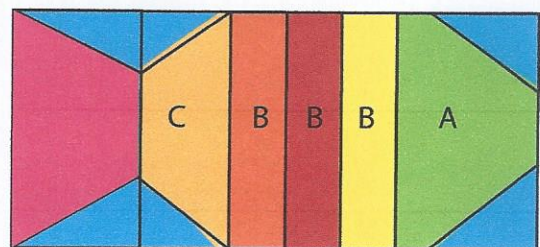
Make fish tail: With D block right side up, place the remaining background squares RST over D block. Sew on line, press and trim.

Complete fish by adding the tail block to the C block side of the fish.  
 Make a second fish.

Sew the two fish together, one facing up and one facing down.  
 You now have One fish, Two fish!!!!



Quilters abbreviations:  
 RST = Right Sides Together  
 HST = Half Square Triangle
