

BLOCK OF THE MONTH - Celebrating Packy's birthday April 14, 1962

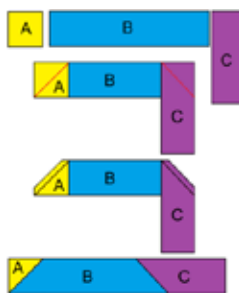
Lorna from Sew Fresh Quilts has allowed us to use her elephant quilt block pattern for our April BOM.

Sew Fresh Quilts – Elephant Quilt Block

Block measures 12" wide x 10" high finished

STOP: Stitch, Trim, Open & Press. To perform the STOP

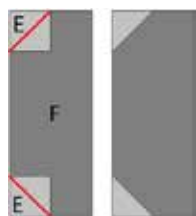
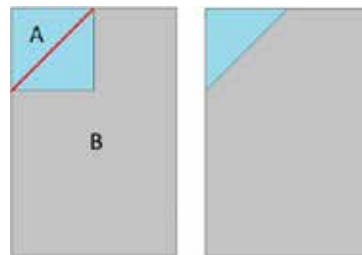


method, align a square (A) or rectangle (C) on the corner of the unit (B) with right sides facing together. Draw a diagonal line and then sew along this diagonal line. Trim a ¼" seam. Finger press the seam open and then press with a hot iron. Pressing the seams open to reduce bulk is recommended.

Press all seams open. Press seams as you go.

Read through entire instructions before beginning.

Step 1: Use the STOP METHOD to add the (A) square on the corner of the (B) rectangle.

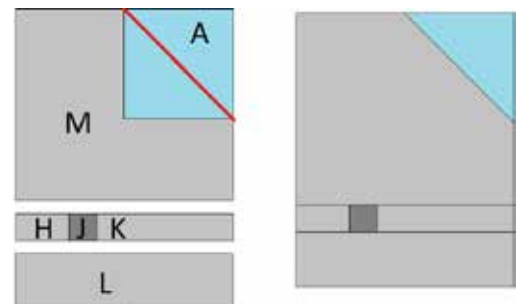
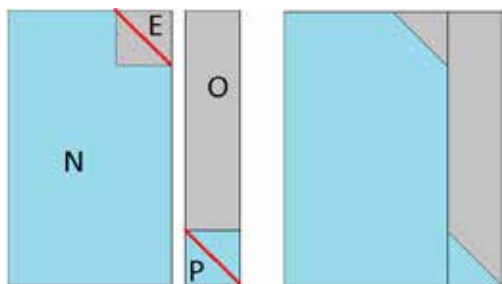


Step 2: Use the STOP METHOD to add the (E) squares on the corners of the (F) rectangle.

Step 3: Use the STOP METHOD to add the (A) square to the corner of the (M) rectangle. Sew the (H) and (K) rectangles on the sides of the (J) square. Sew the (HJK) units onto the bottom of the (MA) unit. Then sew the (L) rectangle onto the bottom.

	J	1 @ 1" square

Step 4: Use the STOP METHOD to add the (E) square on the corner of the (N) rectangle and to add the (P) square on the end of the (O) rectangle. Sew the (NE) unit to the left side of the (OP) unit.
