

BLOCK OF THE MONTH - October Flower

Blocks due October 1st, the block will be selected at the October meeting. Please email a photo of your block to Paula before the meeting. After the winning block is selected you will then mail your block to the winner. Paula can put photos of all the entries on our Northwest Quilters Facebook page.

Fabric Choices: Flower – Blue or purple print (Color 1)
 Blue or purple 'solid' (Color 2)
 Center of flower – orange or yellow
 Background – choose white or off-white

Flower:

Color 1: A – 4" x 4" Cut 4 (will yield 8 triangles)

Color 2: B – 2" x 6 1/2" Cut 2

C – 2" x 3 1/2" Cut 2

Center: D – 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 1

Background:

E – 4" x 4" Cut 4 (will yield 8 triangles)

F – 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cut 4

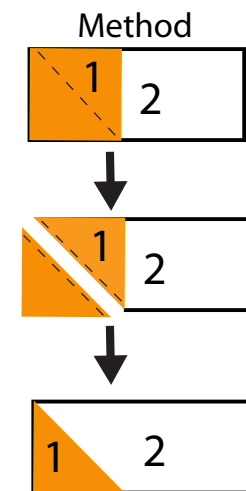
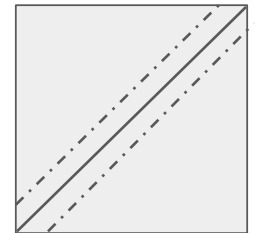
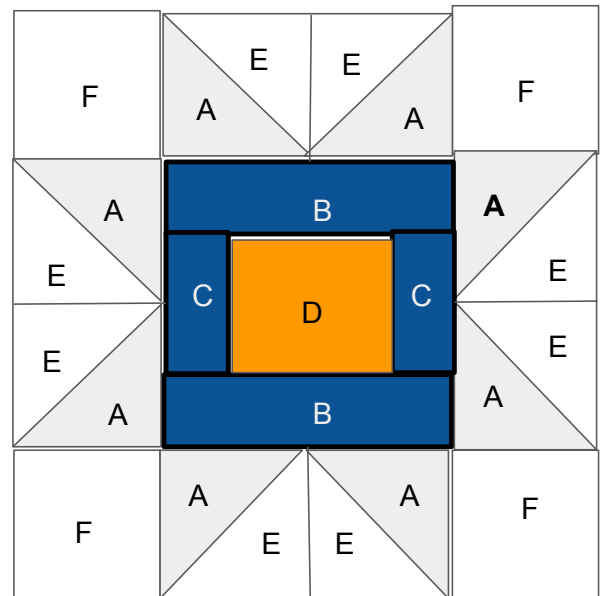
Assemble:

Make 1/2 square triangle: Place one A square and one E square right sides together. Draw diagonal line. Sew scant 1/4" seam on either side of diagonal line. See diagram. Cut along diagonal line. Open and press, then trim to 3 1/2" square.

Repeat with remaining A squares and E squares.

Sew remaining pieces together following block diagram.

Finished size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" to make 12" quilt block.



Quilters abbreviations:
 RST = Right Sides Together
 HST = Half Square Triangle
